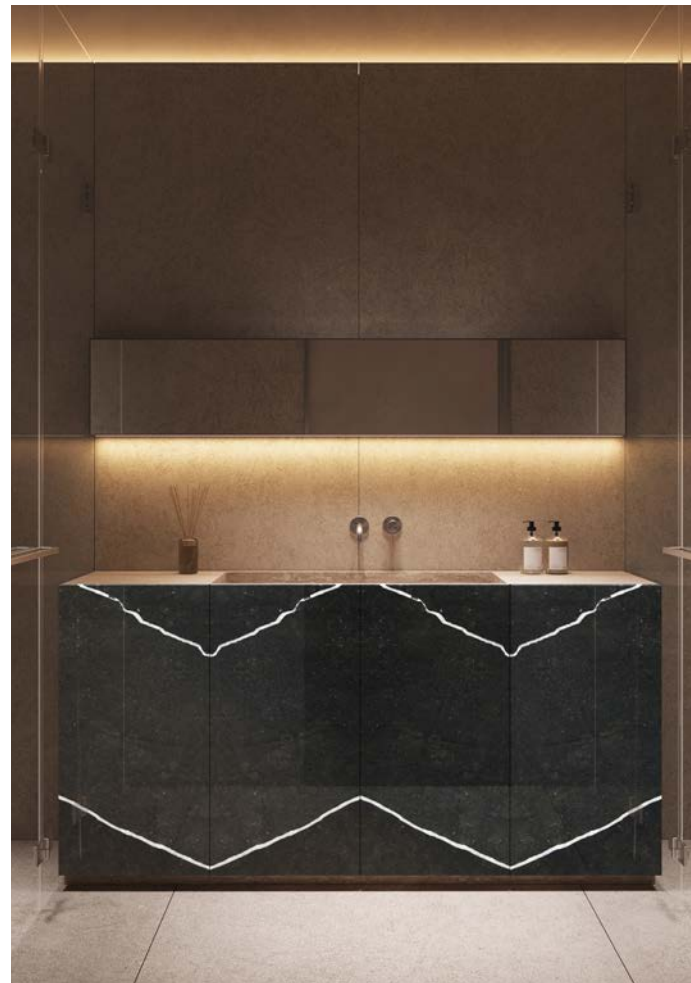

Giacomo Puccini loved Brussels, visiting the city regularly and ultimately dying there in 1924. A hundred years later, in January 2024, Carrières du Hainaut launches its new artistic product-line named Puccini Blue in the great composer's honour. Like the lines and notes on Puccini's scores, slabs of Puccini Blue have been inscribed by nature with unique compositions of white veins and fossils.

In honour of Italy's last great opera composer and his lifelong pursuit of beauty, Puccini Blue transforms Belgium's most beloved natural product into a space where beauty and destiny are fused into a single work of art. Puccini Blue, a harmony in stone.
